ProsperUS Detroit graduate and pitch competition winner, Ceairia Haynes is serving a hearty fare on a van full of variety.

Singing and dancing surrounded by loved ones, coupled with a delicious meal is how Ceairia Haynes fell in love with cooking. In fact, she prepared her first full course meal at age seven. Yes, seven years old cooking fried chicken and spaghetti. As you can see she has always loved to cook and we know, that love goes into every dish.

Peppered throughout Ceairia's story is the heart of a hustler. As a young mother making ends meet by selling delicious meals, also wanting to fill a gap during COVID, she pulled her culinary skills out and made literal lemonade to sale to neighbors, friends, and family. The sales went so well she bought a vacant lot, pitched a tent and started selling meals as well in her neighborhood. Serving her community while providing for her family. Literally, grass roots marketing. The outcomes of these efforts allowed Boujee Eatz to purchase its first trailer and her entrepreneur life was taking flight.

Motherhood and its responsibilities out weighed Ceairia's business pursuits as she navigated her child's autistic needs. Joining the ProsperUS Detroit cohort was just the come back she needed to take all she had built to the next level with information, tools, and support.

Graduating from ProsperUS Detroit gave Ceairia the sure footing she needed to build her confidence to pitch and continue her re-brand. Gaining the necessary resources and funding will also allow her to purchase her first food truck.

The Boujee Eatz menu takes you around the world in a week. From Mexican, Italian, American and Soul Food of course. That's exactly where Ceairia wants to take her business, looking to have a sit down restaurant or a fleet of food trucks, perhaps even both, in the next five years.

Winning the ProsperUS Detroit pitch competition made Ceairia feel great and boosted her confidence. So much so, she's going to try her hand at more pitching to fund her business.

Ceairia says you will taste and experience her story with each bite. When the food trailer is parked in the off season, you will be able to purchase catering of those dishes for the holidays like dressing or macaroni and cheese. Food that warms your heart and fills your belly while spending time with family. The same way her story began.

Fraud Guard is a free service provided by

Bernard J. Youngblood

Wayne County Register of Deeds.

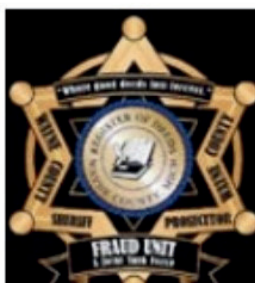
It is a simple way to monitor your land records and warn you of potential property fraud.

Instructions:

- Go to waynecountylandrecords.com > “Fraud Guard” tab.
- Enter the email (twice to confirm) and press “I Agree.”
- On the next page type in the name for monitoring and press “Add Alert”. You can add more than one name.
- When done, press “Save My Alerts”.
- You will receive a confirmation email. Any property alerts will be sent via email.
- Submit a fraud complaint at waynecounty.com/register or call 313-224-5869.
